#### **HONOR:**

Move the right "h" hand, palm facing left and fingers pointing up, in a slight arc toward the face and then downward to in front of the chest. Sign in this song is directed above to Jesus.



#### MY

Pat the palm of the open right hand with a double movement to the center of the chest.




# I, ME:

Point the extended right index finger to the center of the chest with palm facing right. Keep thumb beside the index finger.

**FORMAL ME**: In this song, one hand, palm up, finger tip facing body, starting near shoulders goes down the sides of your body until arm is

KING, PRINCE, CHRIST, LORD: (Christ is illustrated, using the "C" sign, the sign "K" will be used, meaning King.)
Beginning with the index-finger side of the right "C" hand touching the left
side of the chest, palm facing left, move the hand down to touch again,

KING - use "K"; PRINCE - use "P" LORD - use "L"; use "C" for CHRIST
